

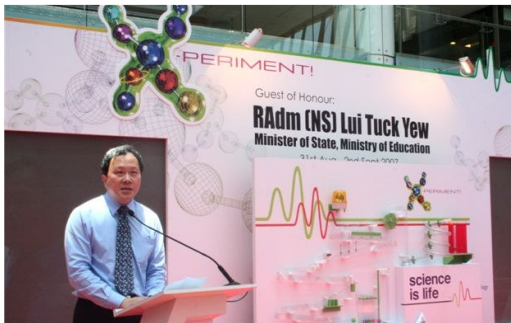
Cool science, real science, fun science, the most happening research and the latest technology, they are all here at X-periment!

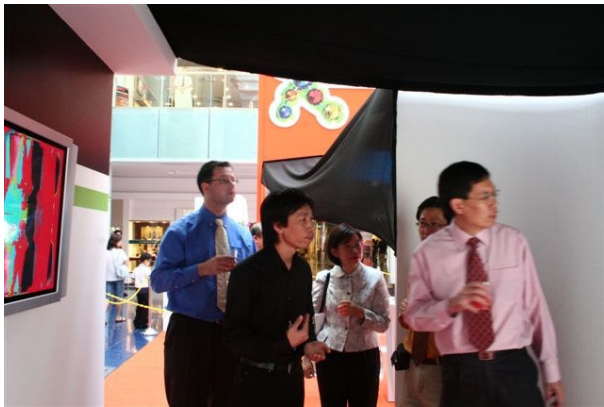

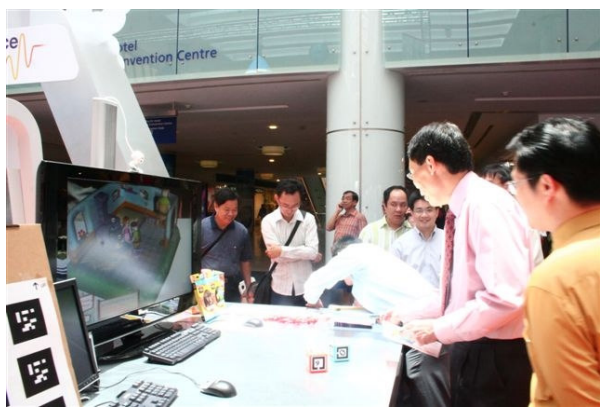
